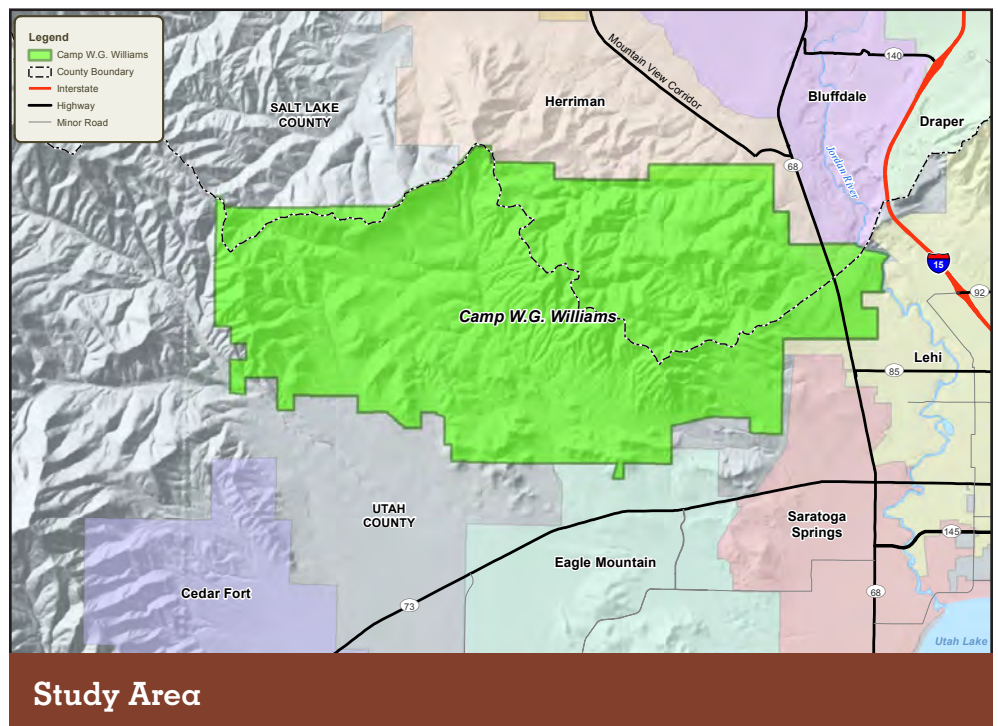
*Welcome and thank you for coming! This FACT SHEET is intended to give you some basics about the project and tonight's Open House. Please take one home and keep it as a handy reference.*

## The Open House

The project's consultant has worked with the Steering Committee to develop DRAFT recommendations. These include different steps each participating community and its citizens can take to help increase cooperation, collaboration and communication between Camp Williams and each community. The recommendations vary by community and are tailored to emphasize and address the issues that are most relevant in those communities.

## Community Information Booths

Each participating community has a "booth" where you can find information about these draft recommendations, and what if anything, they mean to you, directly. We need to know what you think about these recommendations and if you support them. Each booth is staffed by knowledgeable and friendly representatives from each community, so make sure to ask questions. See what your Town is doing already to help! There are comment cards available for you to fill in as well. And don't forget to pick up a copy of the community's project brochure to take home with you!



## Camp Williams Booth

Camp Williams is also staffing a booth with lots of information about the facility, its history, its operations and its contributions to the region. Please take advantage of this opportunity to meet their representatives and to learn more about this unique and essential asset.

## Next Steps

After the Open Houses, the project team will gather all the input, evaluate it and collectively decide what changes should be made to the draft recommendations and to the overall program emphasis. Final recommendations will be compiled for each community and these will be forwarded to each community's legislative authority (typically the City Council) for review and hopefully endorsement. In fact, some City's are already considering project recommendations concerning General Plan updates and other "compatibility tools."
